English:

- 11 & U – class: 1, 6, 11, 12, 16, 18.
- 12 – 14 – class: 2, 7, 11, 13, 16, 18.
- 15 – 17 – class: 3, 8, 11, 14, 16, 18.
- 18 & O – class: 4, 9, 11, 15, 16, 18

Western:

- 11 & U – class: 1, 18, 23, 28, 32, 37, 38, 39
- 12 – 14 – class: 2, 18, 24, 28, 33, 37, 38, 39
- 15 – 17 – class: 3, 18, 25, 28, 34, 37, 38, 39
- 18 & O – class: 4, 18, 26, 28, 35, 37, 38, 39

RULES:

- USEF rules, unless BHSA rules take precedence.
- High Point is based on one horse/one rider combination.
- Entries riding in class 20, 22, 23 or 29 shall not participate in any other classes except class #1 – showmanship, 11&U
- Participants may not be penalized for wearing an ASTM/SEI certified helmet in any class.
- Novice Rider and Novice Horse may not have won more than three blue ribbons in the same division.
- Chaps will not be allowed in the bareback class.

In Western Riding, simple lead changes will be allowed. Properly executed flying changes will score higher than simple changes. It is the judge's opinion as to when a proper simple change begins to outscore a poorly executed flying change.

Riders age 17 and under, may not exhibit stallions. Management reserves the right to combine, split or cancel classes as necessary.
