RULES

- **Age:** Age of rider is determined by rider's age on 12-1-2007
- **US Equestrian Rules** apply unless BHSA rules take precedence
- **Versatility Class** Ride the first direction of the ring in English tack, then change your tack to Western and ride the second direction in Western tack. To be judged on the horse's performance as an English and a Western horse. 2 grooms allowed per entrant.
- **Family and Friends Pleasure Class** One rider rides one direction of the arena; a second rider rides the same horse/same tack the other direction. Two entry fees for this class. No tack changes allowed only stirrup adjustments.
- **Chaps and shorts** will not be permitted in bareback classes
- **BHSA Medal Class** must have at least three participants
- **High Point** does not include classes: 16, 24, 30
- **Entries close** one class prior to class entered into the arena
- **High Point** is based on all classes except 16, 24 and 30. Riders in Western Reining must declare horse for high point before class if they are riding multiple horses.
- **Entries** riding in classes 16 and 24 shall not participate in any other classes except showmanship
- **In accordance with the US Equestrian Rules**, participants may not be penalized for wearing an ASTM/SEI certified helmet in any class.
- **Age 17 and under** riders may NOT show stallions
- **Unruly and/or dangerous** horses or riders will be excused.
- **Reatas and chaps are optional**
- **Classes with 3 or less** entrants may be combined or cancelled
- **Whips, crops and spurs** are optional for English Classes
- **Classes 19 and 29** require two entry fees per class. Riders shall wear same back number. Please specify who you are riding with when you sign up for the class.
- **No Refunds on scratches**
